

The Larger Toyama Core Partner City Region (Toyama Area) is home to the mysterious Toyama Bay, known for its firefly squid and broad velvet shrimp, as well as the Toyama Plain, which stretches out around the Bay, and the majestic peaks of the Tateyama Mountain Range.





This waterfall has a straight drop of 24 meters. The lateral depression seen on the right-side when facing the waterfall water and the spray from the waterfall, thereby inspiring the name of the waterfall Iwamuro (rock room) Falls.
