



The Iwase area once prospered as a port of call for the Kitamae cargo vessel, and is currently home to a number of historically valuable buildings. These have been preserved along Omachi Niikawamachi Street, which was designated a Japan Heritage site in May 2018. Another feature of this area is the Fugan Suijo Line, a canal cruise connecting Fugan Canal Park and Iwase.



Yatsuo Area

Hometown of Owara Kaze no Bon (Harvest Wind Festival)

A hilly town. Yatsuo boasts a variety of traditional cultural aspects, such as the nationally famous folk song, "Owara," and the luxuriously decorated Hikiyama floats. The Owara song is played both during the pre-event and the actual days of the Kaze no Bon Festival accompanied by the melancholic sound of the two string instruments, shamisen and kokyu, and an elegant dance. The Machinagashi parade is one of the main features of this festival.
