Tateyama-Kurobe Alpine Route

Majestic 20m high walls of snow!

offer a truly impressive sight.

This gorge, stretching approx. 15 km, displays

beautiful natural views, especially in autumn.

Toyama City serves as a gateway to this route, which is traversed by various means of transportation, including cable cars, trolley buses, and a ropeway, connecting both Toyama and Nagano Prefectures through the Northern Japan Alps. From mid-April to mid-June, a whole section of the route becomes accessible to visitors, allowing them to get up close to the huge walls of snow that line both sides of the road used by tourist buses. These walls, called Yuki no Otani, are created through skillful snowplowing, and reach heights of almost 20 meters in parts, equivalent to the height of a 7-story building, in years with very high snowfall. This snow-wall section is only accessible by bus, and gives passengers an opportunity to participate in the unique and awe-inspiring event, "Yuki no Otani" Snow Wall Festival, in which they can walk between the walls.
