Streetscape of Iwase

Once part of Iwase's commercial center, this street now houses various artisans, shops, and the Mori Residence and Masuda Brewery, in carefully preserved and renovated 19th century wooden buildings. The bronze ship sculpture at the north-east end replicates a Kitamaebune, the traditional cargo ship used on the Sea of Japan in the 17th-19th centuries. These ships transported kelp, herring and fertilizers from Hokkaido to other parts of Japan, and brought great wealth and different cultures to Iwase. Across the street is Tajiri, an outstanding sake and wine shop.

## Tateyama-Kurobe Alpine Route

Majestic 20 m-high walls of snow!

This alpine route, traversed by various means of transportation, including cable cars, trolley buses, and a ropeway, connects both Toyama and Nagano Prefectures through the Northern Japan Alps. Toyama City is the gateway to this route. Along the alpine route, huge walls of snow line both sides of the road in April when the whole section of the route becomes accessible. These walls are created through snowplowing and can reach up to almost 20 meters in height in high snow seasons, which is equivalent to the height of a 7-story building. This snow-wall section is usually only traversable by vehicles, but is open to pedestrians from April to mid June for a unique and awe-inspiring event called "Mt. Tateyama Snow Wall Walk."
